

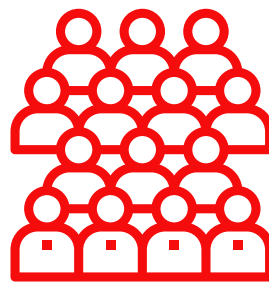

addicted to opioids.

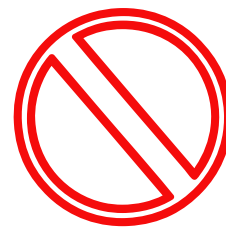
## Recognizing Opioid Addiction:
